## Young people and vulnerable adults

Personal safety is important. You have the right to be and feel safe. People should not harm or abuse you, or threaten to do this.

Your responsibilities are to respect other people's rights to safety, and not to harm, abuse or harass others or threaten to harm, abuse or harass them.
