


Level 3 UAL Diploma in Creative Media Production and Technology



What is it all about?

The UAL awarding body provides for a very student centred approach to learning. There are of course required learning outcomes to be achieved but these are accomplished by the student in a way that is shaped by their pathway, think of it as a learning journey.

The Diploma is the first year qualification that you will achieve on this level 3 programme. You can then, providing you pass, progress onto the second year which is the Extended Diploma. Both of these qualifications attract significant UCAS points to enable your next steps to higher education.


Level 3 Diploma - Year 1



The Diploma consists of 8 units. Units 1-7 are graded at either Pass or Fail and must be passed in order to progress to Unit 8 which is the Final Major Project. Unit 8 is where your grade for the year is determined once you have learnt and honed your skills in the preceding 7 Units.



Units 1-7 make up the taught sessions. They are assessed via set tasks and small projects. Think of the course like a hurdle race, once you clear each unit, you move on. Some units may be individual, some may be grouped.



Level 3 Extended Diploma - Year 2



As with the first year there are a set amount of units, with attached learning outcomes, which need to be passed in order to progress to Unit 13, The **Extended Project in Creative Media** Production. This big, end of year project, is where your final grade is determined (Pass, Merit, Distinction). It is still up to you, the student, to decide your path and follow it.



If you want to focus on photography, you can. You want to focus on film, you can. If you want to focus on games, you can! After the first year, where a variety of skills are learnt, now is the time to really fine tune the direction you are going to take. Units 9-12 are the taught units leading up to the Final Major Project Unit 13.
